	Test opening and closing of the trunk with auto-close button. The door should latch and seal automatically.
	Test opening and closing of the frunk—be sure to check that there is no visible wear on the edges due to rubbing of panels.
	Ensure door windows auto-close completely when doors are closed.
	Check all front and rear exterior lights for signs of internal condensation.
	With all doors open, inspect the weather seals around door gaps and windows for correct alignment.
3) Si	t in Driver's Seat
	Check for any error messages on the display.
	Touch the "Tesla T" at the top of the screen to bring up the "About Your Tesla" window. Tap the unicorn drawing to access the Sketch Pad. Leave the Sketch Pad up for a minute to make sure there are no phantom touches happening on the display (drawing will appear if this is the case).
	Test the driver and passenger door emergency release buttons. Located underneath the handle.
	Open and close all four windows from the driver seat to make sure controls work properly.
	Test the HVAC, listen for strange noises on both hot and cold settings.
